**Suffused Self Colour** Too many variations to make a decision on the best colour, indeed the nick name of confused self colour was the order of the day...

**Clearwings** A further comment on this class would be to say that some would not be out of place in the Greywing class ...

**Cinnamons** Most were of poor body colour and had too much ground colour in the wings with the usual poor wing pattern of all other varieties and the colour of the markings too light and not clearly defined, 143/2 was the exception to these comments.

**Opalines** Go close to being normals with very poor colour

**Lacewings** Poor colour and poor markings

**Fallows** Uneven colour and too light, 202/1 the exception but still a lot of yellow in the body colour.

**Spangles** 211/5 the only one of good variety, the remainder the black markings not nearly as sharply defined as required by the Standard and the spots were not circles.

**AOSV Spangle** did not really define the second variety they carried..

**Recessive Pied** In the main were rather flat in colour and too light

**Red Eye Self Colour** Lutinos too light in colour while the Albinos were showing suffusion in the body colour. Both Lutinos and Albinos had wings a different shade to the body colour.

Maybe if NSW was to improve in this area we might win the ANBC Championship.

I must say that at times I found myself judging the class and would have had a different result had I not stepped back and said "look at the 40 points" .....

Summing up I thought it was an interesting exercise and as it was advertised as a variety show, a great idea....

## JUDGING THE 40 POINTS ( i.e. 25 Colour, 15 Markings )

On Sunday September 14<sup>th</sup> I was asked by Dennis Becket of the Northside Branch BSNSW, to pick the bird that was best variety i.e. to be the closest to the 40 points. This was only one of some new innovations he introduced at their Annual Show. This not only breathed a bit of fresh air into our sometimes same as last week's show results, but made a very interesting and enjoyable day . My selections do not reflect on the Judges for the day, who did an excellent job, but looks at the birds from a different angle .

My selection as the best of the 40 points went to a Clearbody 187/1 . This bird was golden yellow with very clear black markings and stood out in a class of birds that were heavily suffused with green.

My second best was a Dominant Pied 263/1, this bird's sky blue body colour was better than the Normals benched on the day, pied markings were very even and snow white.

My third selection was the Clearwing 122/3, good colour in both body and wing colour but had some very slight traces of melanin in the wing and probably only one of the in that group that was a true clearwing.

My fourth choice was the Greywing 132/2, this bird really was 50% body colour but had the correct grey colour in the wings, the birds with the darker body colour ( i.e. approaching full body colour ) had markings almost black and not the intent of the Standard.

My summing up of the other varieties is as follows : - **Green Series** in the main body colour flat, not bright, mask always divided with the spots not round and the wing pattern badly scrambled and smudgy. Two birds had much better masks and spots than their competitors. They were Green 013/5 and Grey Green 023/2. These two had the best mask & spots I have seen on any normal for some time.

**Blue Series** The same as green series remarks but with the body colour patchy and not even throughout ...

**English Yellowface** Colour very poor although not suffused, yellowface hardly yellow

**Australian Yellowface** 076/1 very good coloured bird but fell away in markings, the rest too green ...

**Black Eyed Self** Too greenish with a few exceptions however old problem of having too much melanin sites on the wing, some with green rumps ...

dad would pick the young leaves off for me every few days. The birds seemed to like them. When the plant got to about one meter tall it started getting black berries forming on it. At that point dad knew straight away that we had been nurturing and feeding a plant called 'Deadly Nightshade' to the birds for about a month. Ooops! Anyway no harm but it could've got very ugly. We had also given some of the seed to pop and he managed to grow the proper plant and has been feeding it regularly to his birds.

I have been thinking more about ways to get juniors involved in budgies. Of course a simple way is to bring them along to shows. If you have nephews, nieces or grandchildren that show interest in your budgies at home, offer to bring them along even if they don't stay the whole time. Why not give them a pair of birds to breed at their own home, and every time they come and visit you they could see what's happened and if they have any eggs or better still if babies have hatched. It's all about getting and keeping their interest.

Recently a member from one of the clubs was telling my dad about their upcoming show where they were making it special for juniors. They are offering juniors free exhibitor entries into the show and free membership to their club. But better still, juniors will have their own awards section, the same as for novice, intermediate and open. At most of our shows the people that have the most experience with the budgies win a lot of the big awards and the juniors struggle to get much of a chance. So I think it sounds like a fantastic idea and something that other clubs should think about. Some people might think that you have to wait your turn to win the awards which I understand. But if you want to attract and keep the interest of young people winning a trophy goes a long way. With any type of club, not just budgies, I think it's good to have young people coming through the ranks.

By the time you read this article the show I'm talking about will have already taken place so I'll report back in the next edition on how successful it was. I haven't mentioned the name of the club (although I think it would be OK) because I haven't asked for permission, but I'll do that before I report back.

Over the hot summer period I put the majority of my birds in the aviary and let them have a bit of a rest before the new year started. I went to my first show a couple of weeks back and I took six birds. I won best Novice Cinnamonwing and best Novice Recessive Pied. I also took three pairs to sell. It was my first major attempt to sell my birds at a show and I sold one of the pairs. They were two recessives (hen and cock). As it turns out I could've sold three times on the day. I think this was because it is so hard to breed good Recessive Pieds and these were nice birds.

Since my last article I have been very busy with my budgerigars. A couple of months before Christmas I received an email from Australian BirdKeeper Magazine (ABK), and they offered me an opportunity to submit an entry for a competition they do every year. All I had to do was write about my experiences with birds and add photos and all that. I was really keen because first prize was \$200 and publication in their magazine. I am really hoping I win because then I can pay back dad for all of the budgie vitamins and supplements he bought for me last year. The entries closed at the end of December so I still might be in with a chance. I'll let you know how I go.

This main topic I would like to talk about in this edition is feeding green pick. If you have any information or advice for me about this topic please email me at [paul\\_jody@optusnet.com.au](mailto:paul_jody@optusnet.com.au) and put 'Sophie' in the subject title.

I like to give the birds a little treat every day when I feed them. I mainly feed carrot and alternate this with apple. I do this because these are things we always have. I would prefer to give them green food, however I don't have much in the way of suitable gardens to grow green food and dad is nervous about buying it from the shops because it may have pesticides on it that can't be properly washed off. We have fed organic kale bought from the shop a couple of times without any problems. The birds ate it but I wouldn't say they loved it – can't blame them for that! You might have heard the saying about kale – 'if you are having a bad morning, just think, someone somewhere in the world is having a kale smoothy'!

I have started feeding gum leaf branches and they love them. Pop told me about this and also to drench the leaves in water so they have a little bath while they eat. In one small garden we have chic weed that grows during winter and they love that as well. Pop taught me never to feed green pick to the birds in the afternoon as it may cause diarrhoea and other problems.

Once I sold a bird to a lady and she gave me and dad this plant that she called 'Chorea' that apparently her birds (parrots) love. She said the seed heads are quite milky and the parents feed it to the babies. We dried out some seed heads and sprinkled the seeds in our small garden. We noticed some seedlings coming up and watered them each day. One plant grew about half a meter and

9. Depending on weather, winter is looming and birds tend to go into a terrible moult, how can you assist there dietary needs. You need to increase protein. I started rolled oats in 2011, as this is one of the highest protein foods available to birds. Greens, vegetables and fruit can cause havoc when you get closer to grooming your birds for pre-selections. Reduce these now. Start protein from 4/4/2015. Spray your birds on sunny days not wet or overcast days!!!
10. Spots, remove 9/5/2015. Will take 3-5 weeks to regrow depending on feather of birds. Books say 2 weeks, I have allowed 6 weeks, feather on English birds are different, longer and wider, require more time to grow. What after tails and flights is the next most disappointing item not to have completed on your show birds??
11. Time for baycox again, 2 day treatment, week commencing 2/5/2015.
12. Remember you have already adding to your spraying routine by completely dipping your show team. Spraying starts from the 25/4/2015 giving you 7 weeks, as you get closer to the pre-selection, the spraying goes from heavy to a mist. Use hot water to begin, in the 2 weeks closer to the preselection use cold water.
13. Week commencing 23/5/2015 worm your birds again for 2 days.
14. From 25/5/2015; start spraying with cold water, not hot; remember the spraying is less heavy now, mainly a mist. Two weeks to Pre-selection, 3 to National Show. Start to open pin feathers and remove wax slowly from flight and tail regrowth.
15. Week commencing 1st of June wash and rinse your birds in warm water with no more tears shampoo. Open pin feathers where showing all over bird. Clean blood off from washing using full cream milk. Use corn flower in head and body to absorb blood, this will dry and dissipate within 1-1.5 hours maximum or sooner depending on weather conditions. You will/may need to wash again closer to your club pre selection show and again prior to the SQBBA preselection show.
16. Assess you team. On the 13/6/2015, final preparation is now completed, your club pre-selection awaits, wash and rinse again; for the SQBBA preselection use a feather on the morning of the show and spread paraffin oil on the bird's feet and beak. Do not remove spots as the careers will prepare birds selected to compete at the Nationals. Pack you team into the car and good luck at the pre selection show.

If you require further information on removing/cutting or the growth of flights, tails or spots on you show team I would only be too happy to assist. Blood feathers, pin feathers can cause problems I will explain and show you how to use full cream milk, corn flower, shampoo and rinsing to remedy a problem prior to any preselection. I can also assist on opening pin feathers, tail and flight feathers if required. What I have listed above is a process of preparing budgerigars for a National Show, it has worked for me, you do not have to use this, but I hope you can all take something from this information. Please call me if you require further information or displays on the above information listed, I will be happy to help you.

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## PREPARATION OF YOUR BIRDS FOR THE NATIONALS

1. Work on a time line back from the National Show, work on 12 weeks, this year the start date is the 28/3/2015. Aim for completion to be as close to the SQBBA pre-selection show (11 weeks), you have 1 week spare for contingencies.
2. Select the birds you want to prepare from the 21/3/2015, if you are not confident, ask for another breeder's opinion. Make the following notes so you can keep records on the progress of your birds and what utensils do we need to use:

Do you put your birds into holding cages or work on them from the flights?

3. Work begins, tails first, books say allow 6-8 weeks, but from experience allow 8-10 weeks, you're aiming to have tails dropped or pulled by the 11/4/2015 two weeks after assessment of your national candidates. Cut tails from the 28/3/15 if you do not want to pull, leave it 5cm long. Depending on how old the tail is, check the blood in the quill. If you have blood, this is a new tail and possibly still growing, do not remove, and work on only removing the dry quill tail only. By cutting you give the bird a chance to loose this tail naturally. If the tail has not dropped by the 11/4/2015 then you have to remove it. Do not remove new tails growing. What is the most common fault with condition of birds leading up to the Nationals? Tails falling out!
4. Baycox' a 2 day program on the weekend of the 11th/12th of April, ideally should be every 3 weeks. To prevent coccidiosis. Take water away early to ensure drinking, when water is replaced at lunch time, do the same for worming.
5. On the 11/4 Check problem flights, I tend to remove only the last 2-3, flight numbers six, seven and eight, I also cut these so the birds will loose them naturally. Cut and leave 4cm on the 11/4. Check to see if tails have started growing. Books suggest 4-6 weeks to grow flights, experience indicates 5-7 weeks to grow, less for flights 1-5.
6. Remove flights up to 1-2 weeks after cutting (18/4 or 25/4/2015). Be careful here when removing. You now have 8 weeks to the Nationals. 1 week extra allowed.
7. Worm Birds, a 2 day treatment, week commencing 25/4/2015. How are tails growing, how are flights growing? Growth; assist by applying paraffin oil and or vaseline. Extra dipping of tails/flights in water also promotes growth faster, up to a 1/2 an inch more can be added in the same time frame. Do not spray on wet days!
8. Commence 3 week dipping process, 2/5, 9/5 and 16/5. All birds get dipped. 10ml of ivomec per litre of water, use a 4ltr ice cream container, 2 litres of this mixture is sufficient in the container. Must be 3 week ends in a row, 7 days apart. This will also assist feather growth and feather condition of your budgerigars.

**Miniatures** There is a buzz all over the World with these special little birds. Are these miniatures something really special or are they just pet shop birds or what they call in the US and South Africa – “cowboys”? I have just bought three pairs from one of the top breeders in Europe so they have to be the real deal – but I have my doubts. I thought they were small, colourful budgies but a “type” bird.

I maybe have a lot to learn about these birds and I will start off by breeding a few and following what is happening around the world. These I have here look nothing like the birds I have seen as the Australian standard. These are with big eyes, big beaks and bite like hell when you try to catch them.

**UK Club show v AZ show in Germany** I had the pleasure is seeing the birds at both of these top shows. The UK show came first and I was disappointed at so many of the colour group winners at the Doncaster show. Far too many were flecked, unfit and with too much rough feather to be show birds. Yes, there were some wonderful “stock birds” winning but they were far from show birds. It was good to run into Aussie fancier Jean Painter at the show.

A couple of weeks later came the AZ club show in Karlsruhe in Germany. Those colour group winners were real show birds – no flecking – all the winners were fit and in excellent condition. It restored my faith on budgies and that there is a future for the exhibition budgie.

**It's easier to spend money than it is to make it** It's a time for AGMs here in Europe where officers and committees are elected. It's a time to look at money that has been spent by looking over those accounts and see what savings can be made in the future. It's not easy to get people to take jobs on but there is no job more important than a treasurer. It's easy to spend money but any event needs to be organised with a budget and someone needs to take strong control of the finances.

**Cock or hen goes into the breeding cage first** When we pair up – is it the cock first, the hen first or does it really matter which one goes into the breeding cage first. Chat it through at club meetings and then I will let you have my views next time.

*Let's hope we all have a great 2015 with our birds and if any fancier has any budgie breeding problems, send an e-mail to the editor and he can forward it onto me and maybe we can get a response back to you.*

# The World of Budgies No 1

*There's a new column introduced to Australia. Its from European budgie fancier – Tommie Titmouse. He will appear in several magazines – he will express plenty of positive views and opinions with lots of good tips for budgie fanciers all over Australia.*

Its all gone a bit quiet here in Europe with the end of the shows and people thinking about that breeding season. Just for once I seem to be on top of the jobs! The writing is all up to date – and no deadlines just around the corner. It's time to think about breeding a few budgie – me thinks!

**Birds and Birdroom** Birdroom clean – cages washed and once I can get a bit of bird sorting finished – I might even think about a few pairs going together. Loads of feathers about so once they are through the moult – they might well be about right for a bit of breeding. I have sure not bred the numbers of great birds this time but I did pair up to cut back a bit on feather AND ANY FLECKING. Bred a lot of “nice” birds but some of them are a shade small. I have probably bred 20 really super birds. Absolutely lovely birds! I am convinced we cannot keep breeding for size and feather and it's time to take it all back a bit.

**Walking away** There are fanciers all over the World where there are people walking away from clubs and societies and setting up new clubs. Experience tells me that they do their own thing for a couple of years and then everyone comes back together again. Think long and hard about a breakaway group – fight the battles from the inside and let democracy do its thing.

**Making contact** The end of one year and a New Year is an odd time of the year. Christmas is all about making contact with people you have not seen for a while and for me it's probably one of the best things about this time of the year.

I made a big mistake by not making contact with one of our local fanciers and last week her grandson appeared at my door with bad news. His grandmother had died over Christmas. I had not seen or heard from her for about six months and I should have made contact – I am kicking myself. Don't let it happen to you. Keep in contact with people.

While I am on the subject – fanciers die and they usually leave a partner, husband or wife behind. From time to time it's important that fanciers and clubs also make contact with those left behind. You will hear it time and time again – the fancy is not just about birds!

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
