

Recessive Pieds - Gina Adams (Fred Wright)

I was first attracted to Recessive Pieds by the colour contrast, there is nothing more striking than a good quality Violet Recessive Pied!

They are a recessive variety and breed to those simple rules. The Recessive Pied has to be carried by both parents (either visual Recessive or split) in order to breed Recessive Pieds. Pairing a Recessive Pied to a normal budgie (non-carrier of recessive gene) produces all visual normal birds that will be split for recessive. Some split recessives have a spot on the back of the head but not all, so it's not possible to tell visually if a normal looking bird is a carrier - or not.

Putting size and feather into them is the hardest challenge due to the fact that they are a recessive variety and are therefore harder to improve than any dominant variety.

Recessive Pieds should have between 10% and 20% variegation of the total wing area which is hard to maintain, especially in hens which tend be more heavily marked.

The advantage with dark factor Recessive Pieds is that there is greater contrast in the body colours, which make for a more eye catching bird.

If we use a Recessive Pied \times Normal we get all normal/split recessive youngsters. These are called "first splits". How should we use them?

I usually pair first generation splits back to visual Recessive Pieds, although you can pair together two first generation splits together, but the number of visual Recessives you breed is less.

Making improvements with the variety?

I would start with two visual Recessive Pieds, and pair them to the best Normals I could get to breed first-splits. In the second year I would pair the babies from one pair to the other to produce some visual Recessive Pieds. These would more than likely be heavily marked on the wings so I would pair them back to Recessive Pieds to

lighten the wing markings. Heavy marked Recessive Pieds can be "cleaned up" by pairing them to clean winged Recessive Pieds.

We find that by pairing Recessive Pieds to normals improves size and feather, it also improves the spots, as heavier marked Recessive Pieds tend to carry good spots.

If we pair a Recessive with a first split, we get visual Recessives - but we get second splits too - should we use the second splits?

Second generation splits can be used, but in my experience, they tend not to be visually as good as first generation, as they carry more Recessive Pied and less of the normal genes. So unless they were of exceptional quality I personally don't use them.

I am not opposed to using cinnamons, but you have to be aware that as well as diluting wing-markings they will also dilute the body colour, so the contrast will not be as good as in a normal variety Recessive Pied

Selling Recessives

It is easy to sell surplus stock as they make attractive pets/aviary birds. A flight of Recessive Pieds is a sight to behold due to the wonderful contrast of colours.

Showing

They are an easy variety to show due to the fact that they don't need to have spots, and therefore don't need to be de-spotted or trimmed in the mask area. We think it's important to wash heads, tails and flights as the light colour can get quite dirty.

Any colours/varieties that should be avoided? Why?

When breeding them you should avoid pairing them into Dominant Pieds as you can produce odd-eyed Pieds - with an iris in one eye but none in the other. These have to be shown in the Dominant Pied class.

We also avoid pairing them to Spangles, as you can produce Spangle Recessive Pieds, which have to be shown in the Spangle classes

Judging - Is there a problem judging Recessives for some judges? Why?

In our experience some judges tend not to consider the variety markings and just go for the better quality budgie. It can be annoying to be beaten by a Recessive with no variegation on the wings.

We find that in general, hens tend to carry darker wing markings than cocks. In the breeding room we would be more likely to use dark winged hens than dark winged cocks. To lighten up the wing markings we would pair a dark winged hen to a light winged cock and expect to produce a high percentage of light winged babies. It is harder to clean up dark winged cocks as light winged hens are harder to come by.

On the show bench the scale of points is the same for cocks as it is for hens, so the cocks do tend to have the advantage at the shows.

(Gina Adams shows in partnership with her husband Alan. They keep a large stud but it's Gina who concentrates on the "specialist varieties" and these include Crests as well as her Recessive Pieds. Gina has kept Recessive Pieds since she started in the hobby in 1996. The highlight was winning Best Recessive Pied at the B.S Club Show in 2004 and also winning Best Recessive Pied Young Bird at the Specialist & Rares show a few years later. She has registered two champion Recessive Pieds in recent years ...




