ANBC Judges Panel Co-Ordinator

Dear James,

There are currently two motions before the ANBC that are of concern to myself and I would expect fellow ANBC Judges who are aware of the motions.

These motions are on the Agenda seek to extend the dates set for the implementation of the Flecking Disqualifications finally presented in May 2018 by the National Judges Panel from our date of January 2019 to as far out as 2021.

We have struggled with this aspect of Flecking for over 10 years and now we finally have a realistic and fully feasible approach to settle the matter and seem that it could again be undermined by States and Zones of by members misunderstanding or lack information.

The underlying reasons these motions appear on the agenda seems to relate to one key item and that is **Communication** of information to members.

While in my view three years from being minuted seems sufficient time for all to be aware of the matter it is now obvious that the messages are not getting to the grass roots members through a breakdown in this Communication.

After fully reviewing our position on Flecking I believe we have attempted to promulgate too much in one attempt and as such the backlash is coming from members through their States and Zones.

To expedite this important matter, I would like to present a motion for consideration by the ANBC Judges Panel.

MOTION

The ANBC Judges Panel agree implement the Disqualification on Flecked birds to those represented only as Heavily Flecked in line with the attached pictorial.

Introduction to the Standard would be after the 2019 ANBC meeting and thus take effect from the Showing season in 2020.

A further review may be investigated in 2023 for implementation in 2025 if deemed appropriate.

REASONING

The current motion is considered too complex to be readily accepted by members and by only concentrating on the heavily flecked birds at this point will be more acceptable to members.

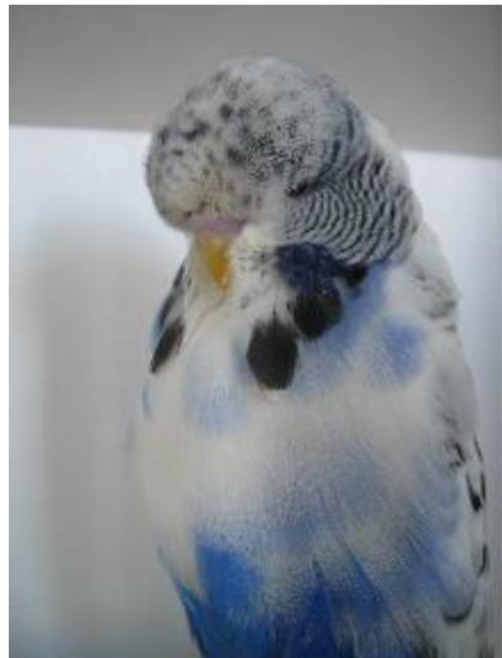
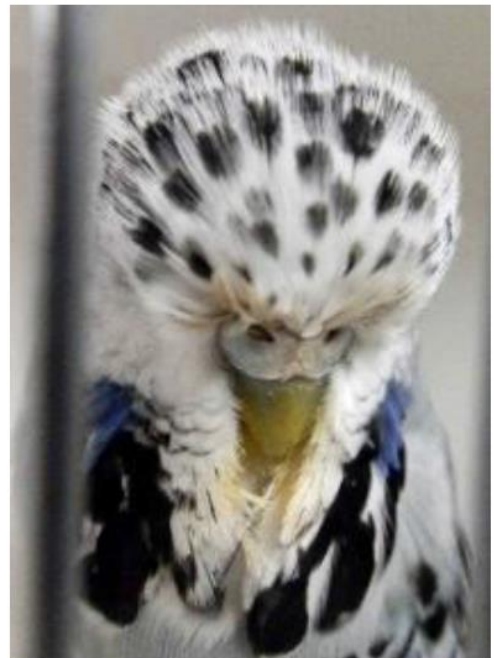
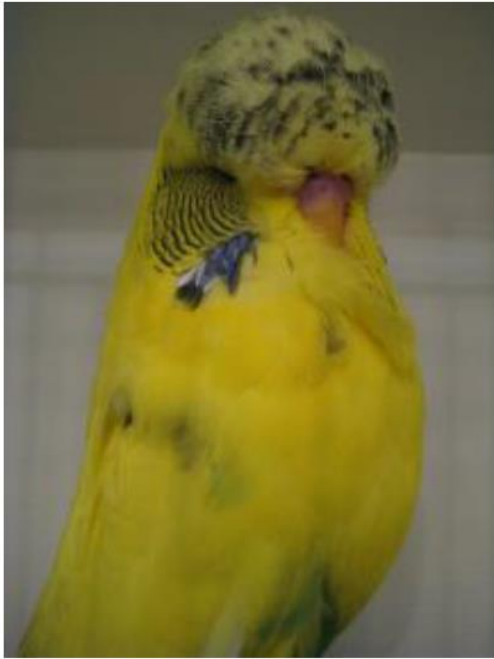
There is also a greater clarity and a lesser impact by simply disqualifying birds that at this point would not likely be presented anyway.

The remaining Flecking clauses would remain in the Standard and birds with the fault continue to be penalized.
